



Snow Day Parking & Towing Notice

Snow Day = No Street Parking

Under City ordinance, a Snow Day occurs when snowfall reaches two inches (2") or more. On Snow Days, parking is restricted on all City streets to allow safe and effective snow removal.

When Do Restrictions Apply?

- Restrictions apply automatically once snowfall reaches 2" or more
- Parking remains restricted until snow removal operations are substantially complete
- Restrictions apply whether or not a public announcement is received

What Is Not Allowed?

- Parking on any City street during a Snow Day
- Parking on designated snow routes during snow operations
- Blocking plows, emergency vehicles, or street access

Enforcement & Towing

- Vehicles in violation may be ticketed and towed without further notice
- Towing and storage costs are the responsibility of the vehicle owner
- Vehicles interfering with snow removal or emergency access will be towed as a priority

Snow Removal Operations

- Snow removal may occur at any hour
- Snow is plowed toward the curb or edge of the street
- The City is not responsible for snow placed in driveways due to normal plowing
