Trash, Recycling, and Yard Waste	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● <b>Garbage pickup:</b> Friday mornings (all garbage must fit in the cart). Stickers are available at City Hall for extra garbage or large items.</li> <li>● <b>Recycling:</b> every other Monday (must be clean and dry).</li> <li>● <b>Yard waste:</b> not allowed in garbage—please use the tree dump (yard waste only).</li> </ul>

### Quick Facts:

**Garbage:** Pick up on Friday mornings - all garbage must fit in the garbage cart provided. Stickers are available at the City Hall for extra garbage or for large items. Set garbage cart at curb with wheels away from the truck.

**Recycling:** Every other Monday - brochure included. There is no limit on recycling. Recycling must be clean and dry!

**Yard Waste:** Not allowed in the garbage - please use tree dump. Tree dump is for yard wastes only, please do not leave any garbage bags or boxes at the dump. Cameras are installed at dump site.

**Outdoor burning reminder:** Recreational fires are allowed with seasoned wood only. No garbage, leaves, or cardboard. No other open burning is allowed.
