INWOOD YARD WASTE SITE

Main Tree Pile

What you are allowed to dump: Branches, Sticks, Trees, Bushes, and Landscape Plants.

What not to dump: Dirt, Rocks, Concrete, Treated Lumber, Anything Plastic, Anything that is not yard waste.
(NO MORE CONCRETE - Please check with Jamie Van Beek with any questions).

Grass Clippings & Leaves (Special area on the east side)

Grass and leaves only—no sticks. Remove from plastic bags and take bags with you. Grass clippings and leaves are spread on farm fields. Please help by not leaving any bags or sticks in this area.

Yard Waste Only. No lumber, pallets, or wood. Any Questions, Please call City Hall (712) 753-4833.

Time again for a reminder about NOT flushing disposable wipes. Trash It! Don't Flush It!

Although many brands of disposable wipes are labeled “flushable”, **don't flush them!** The clogs and backups can cause costly repairs for your home, or increased sewer repairs for the City of Inwood.

Toilet paper is designed to disintegrate in our pipes and sewage systems, but **flushable wipes are not!** They're typically made with synthetic materials, plastics or polyester that won't break down. So even if they flush down your toilet, they end up clogging our sewers.

Non-Flushables

Wipes of any type - hygiene wipes, baby wipes, cleaning wipes, disinfectant wipes, make-up wipes, and more. Paper towels, diapers and kleenex.

SIDEWALK ASSISTANCE PROGRAM

The City will reimburse 50% of the cost of concrete. Applications are available at City Hall.

- To qualify, the work **Must Be Pre-Approved**
- 50% reimbursement is for cost of concrete only, no labor, removal, or other materials shall be covered

INWOOD DOG REMINDERS

- Maximum of 2 dogs per household
- No dogs at large—keep leashed or fenced
- Clean up after your pet - Please carry pet waste bags with you on walks
